This position will also be responsible for identification, participation, reporting, and interpretation of ISO, Utility, and Regulatory issues, rate modifications, and changing business/market rules that impact the organization from a Risk and Supply perspective.

- Manage the company's Environmental compliance requirements in relation to Renewable Portfolio Standards,
 Voluntary Renewable Energy Credit, and Carbon Offsets
- Ongoing maintenance of forward mandatory and voluntary Environmental requirements, coordination with Risk and Supply to plan and meet these needs, and maintenance of an accurate position report
- Perform the timely retirement of Environmental products and submission of compliance reports as required by the States and in ISOs systems.
- Monitor and routinely report on regulatory, compliance, IDO committee & membership meetings, Utility issues, market design changes, and other business-related ongoing information that affects XOOM Energy from a Supply and Risk Perspective.
- Prepare appropriate documentation as necessary to support XOOM new market entries.
- Confirm load data collateral postings calculations and as necessary
- Research new and emerging regulatory activities, market rules, and tariffs affecting the company and update impacted business groups and senior management on a regular basis
- Identify and represent the company on certain coalition panels and initiatives that improve industry operations conditions favorable to the Customer Choice programs and XOOM, as well as the future viability and profitability of XOOM
- Ability to travel occasionally to attend working group meeting in MISO, PJM, NEISO, NYISO and ERCOT
- Be point of contact for all ISO/RTO client reps as well as related regulatory proceedings
