

National Grid Fixed Rate Basic Service Adjustment Details

Residential customers who are currently on a fixed rate plan for Basic Service with their utility and choose to switch to XOOM Energy, or any other Competitive Supplier, before their contract period is over, will have their electricity bill recalculated to reflect the variable rate for that period. This simply means that their bill will be recalculated as if they were on a monthly variable rate for that period. This adjustment may be a credit or debit, and will be reflected on the customer's first bill after the switch is effective.

Customers on a variable rate with the utility will not be affected.

The chart below shows what a typical customer's adjustment would be depending on the month they decide to switch. Actual adjustments would be determined by the individual customer's actual usage.
