

## MESSAGE FROM THE CEO

No other event in recent history has had a more direct impact on our customers' energy usage than the Polar Vortex of last winter. I have been in the energy retail business for 25+ years, and I do not recall an event similar to the winter of 2013-2014. Because of this, XOOM has been busy preparing for the upcoming winter weather.

The prolonged extreme cold weather stressed our country's energy infrastructure unlike anything we have seen. Most consumers do not realize that natural gas has to be injected into storage fields during the summer and withdrawn in the winter in order to meet winter demands. In most areas of the country, delivery capabilities are simply not adequate to deliver 100 percent of demand in a given day. As your energy supplier, we use a combination of deliveries and storage withdrawals to ensure your needs are met. Last winter's extreme cold forced the withdrawal of natural gas from storage at an accelerated rate, depleting storage levels to historic lows. These low storage supplies had a profound impact on wholesale cost in large regions of the country and lead to a great deal of volatility not seen since 2008. Also contributing to this volatility is the fact that most new electric generation in the northeast is powered by natural gas. Unfortunately, the natural gas transmission pipeline capacity in this part of our country was designed to deliver natural gas to residential and commercial users - not power generators.

This new demand for natural gas, combined with transmission constraints, lead to real imbalances in supply and demand, which directly lead to cost spikes. Plus, because of the prolonged cold weather, homes and businesses used considerably more energy last year winter that what they normally use in a typical winter. Needless to say, last winter will not be forgotten anytime soon.

Ultimately, what matters most to you is how all of this affects you and your monthly energy bill. So as we prepare our house for winter, we encourage you to do the same. This edition of TheWIRE offers practical tips and information to assist in managing your winter energy bill.

# SEASONAL PREPAREDNESS

With cooler climate on the way, now is the time to prepare homes and businesses for falling temperatures.

Doing so will help you **manage energy usage** and minimize drastic increases in utility bills.

#### **XOOM ENERGY RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:**

- Remove snow & ice from gas meters
- Set thermostats as low as appropriate to maintain health and comfort
- Limit use of **natural gas appliances**, especially during early morning hours
- **Set water heater** temperature to 120 degrees
- Make sure doors have **weather stripping** and door sweeps
- Install indoor window insulation kits on leaky windows
- **Seal** off unheated, unused rooms
- Open south-facing curtains and blinds during the day, and close them at night

In addition to conserving resources, variable rate customers should consider the benefits of switching to a fixed rate plan. Your fixed rate will not change during the life of your contract. You are protected against unexpected and costly price increases, giving you greater control over the cost of your energy. Although a variable rate may help you realize the lowest possible cost in the market, it also exposes you to possible price increases, and, unlike a fixed rate, does not protect you against price volatility.
